Broughton, a renowned photographer as well as educator in the photographic arts, served as a faculty member at Brooks Institute of Photography for more than 20 years. Broughton, whose teaching experience ranged from both undergraduate and graduate courses such as Basic Digital Photography and Photographic Theory has been recognized for his ability to inspire students. He is currently working on a photographic project about artists in Paris.
